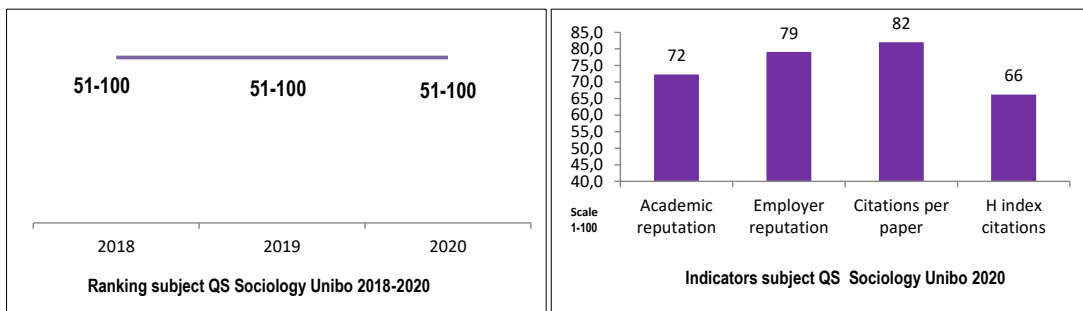

The estimated contribution of the **SDE** department to Subject **Sociology** is **prevalent** but not exclusive. SDE could use this QS label in its external communications, declaring the Department's level of contribution.

PROCEDURE ADOPTED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE FOR QUALITY ASSURANCE TO ESTIMATE THE CONTRIBUTION OF EACH DEPARTEMENT

-Analysis of the population of each department (31 December 2019) and of the SSDs of each researcher (professors and researchers on permanent and fixed-term contracts);

-identification by the Executive Committee for quality assurance of the SSDs that characterise each subject (on a scale from 0 to 10);

-identification of each department's level of contribution to each subject according to this scheme::

PREVALENT accounts for at least 50% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject;

SIGNIFICANT BUT NOT PREVALENT accounts for at least 50% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject;

MINOR BUT PERTINENT accounts for less than 20% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject.

No mention is given to subjects unrelated to at least 4 research staff. And, the subjects in which the university has not been.
